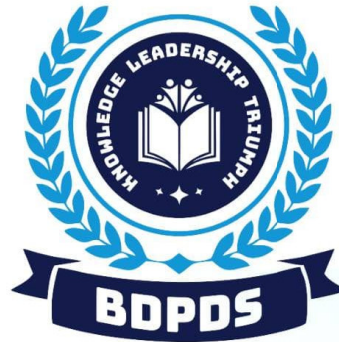

Every academic session marks the beginning of new activities and projects in the school. Hence, every year is a learning year for the students. They practice innovative things and add a new chapter of learning to their lives...

1. On **March 28 and 29, 2024** a two day long **Scout and Guide camp** was organized for classes II - IV. Students participated enthusiastically and learnt the fundamentals of service, team work and community participation.

2. On **March 30, 2024** the **Annual Result Declaration Day** was held. Students enthusiastically collected their performance reports with their parents.

Graduation ceremony was also held for the kindergarten kids who got promoted to class I.

3. On **April 6, 2024** **World Health Day** was celebrated in school to mark the foundation of WHO and also to highlight the significance of good health with "My Health, My Right" being this year's theme of celebration.

4. On **April 22, 2024** **Earth Day** was celebrated in school. The celebration began with a special assembly in which speeches about conservation of resources were presented and a musical performance was delivered by the students.

Various activities like poster making, slogan writing, jar plantation, poem recitation, group chart preparation and many more were conducted at class level for all classes. Students of the pre-primary wing also planted trees.

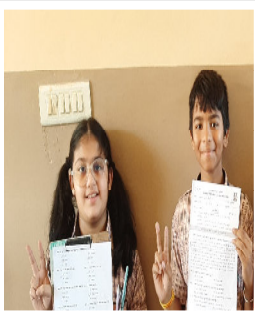
5. From **29th April to 4th May, 2024** **English Week** was observed in the school. During this week, various activities were conducted in the assembly and at class levels like- tongue twisters, skits, poem recitation, monologues etc. The week was concluded by giving appreciation to the good performers.

6. The school organized its' **Summer Camp -2024** from **May 21 to June 5, 2024**. The activities offered were- Robotics, Abacus and Dance.

Students from the school and outside participated enthusiastically. In robotics learnt to make *Johny Walker Robot, Street Light, Automatic Door Opening Robot, Circle Drawing Robot, Sensor Based Crane, See Saw Robot and the basics of coding.*

The dance students learnt about various dance moves and did a lot of stretching exercises for flexibility. Both solo and group dances were prepared.

The first module of Abacus was introduced to the students and basic speed calculations were taught.



The camp concluded with a vibrant event which involved dance presentation, abacus demonstrations and Robot display. The program was concluded by certificate distribution and a dance party.

Parents and students extended full cooperation to make the event a success.

7. On July 1, the school re-opened. **Founder's Day, Doctor's Day and Chartered Accountants Day** were enthusiastically celebrated in the assembly. The principles and values of the founder **Lt. Shri Bhagwan Das Ji Pareek** were emphasized and their relevance for the students was explained.

8. On July 13, the **elections for the Student Council 2024-25** were held. Students participated actively in voting and learnt the concept of democracy practically.

9. On July 15, 2024, the **ECO CLUB of the school was founded**. The teacher and student members of the club were batched. The foundation of the club was marked by plantation of a tree by the school Director Dr. Shachi Pareek. The club aims to -

- a. Promote eco-friendly practices.
- b. Organize environmental activities and events.
- c. Encourage sustainable living.

10. On July 16, 2024, a **Green School Drive** was held in the school. Eco Club members actively participated in the plantation drive.

11. On 19th July, **Guru Purnima** was celebrated in the assembly. The significance of Guru in the life of an individual was highlighted through speeches by teachers and students.

The day was filled with many classroom activities for classes II- VIII. Classes II- V demonstrated their acting skills through a role play activity **"Actor Factor"**.

While students of classes VI - VIII demonstrated their cooking skills through a fireless cooking activity **"Culinary Masters"**.

12. On 26th July, **Kargil Victory Day** was celebrated in school. Students commemorated this day through their speeches. Students of class U.K.G presented a patriotic musical skit.

13. During the **Independence Day week**, card making activity was organized for the entire primary wing. Students made beautiful cards with patriotic quotes.



14. A **“Pre-Independence Day”** celebration was organized for the Pre-primary wing on 14th August,2024. Students presented enchanting dances, songs and also a musical skit depicting the bravery of Indian soldiers.

15. On 17th August, 2024 the festival of **“Rakshbandhan”** was celebrated for the pre-primary classes. The girls tied rakhis to their classmates and they exchanged sweets, chocolates and gifts with each other. Students learnt the significance of this day through this activity.

16. On 24th August, **“Janmashmi”** was celebrated for the pre-primary wing. Students participated in dance, ramp walk and enjoyed Dahi Handi. Students learnt the life lessons from lord Krishna through an educative talk by the teachers.

17. On 5th September, the Birth Anniversary of Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan was celebrated as **Teacher’s Day**. Students from all class levels participated enthusiastically to express their love and gratitude for their teachers. Dances, poems, songs, mimes, titles, gifts and games for the teachers made the day memorable.

18. On 11th September, a session was held on **“Adolescence Education”** for the girls of grade 4 to grade 8.

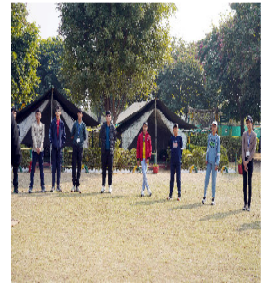
The speaker for the session was Dr. Arti Gothwal, who discussed all major issues concerning adolescence mainly focusing on menstrual health and hygiene.

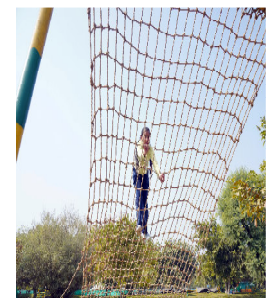
